COVID-19 GUIDELINES

- Players will occupy benches and bleachers. Bleachers will be marked for players to ensure social distancing. No spectators will be allowed to use the bleachers.
- Coaches must wear masks at all times. This includes on the field and in the dugout.
 - Only 3 coaches will be allowed in the dugout.
- All spectators must remain behind the blacktop area directly next to the dugout and bleachers. Spectators should plan on bringing their own chairs and sitting to the outfield side of the bleachers. Spectators are being asked to practice social distancing.
- Umpires will position themselves behind home plate, unless the coaches agree that they would rather the umpire position himself behind the pitcher's mound.
 - No gum chewing, seeds, or spitting.
- Players, coaches, and umpires are not to engage in any physical contact. No high-fives, handshakes, etc. This includes with players and coaches from both teams.
- Coaches are responsible for ensuring compliance with these guidelines, including from their spectators. Coaches and league personnel from Des Plaines Baseball reserve the right to ask anyone not in compliance to vacate the park.
 - Bathrooms will not be available.
- All players should bring their own water. Drinking fountains are not available.
- If anyone is not feeling well, please do not attend. The safety of everyone is our primary concern.
- Please remember that we are also following all guidelines as set forth in the Restore Illinois, Youth and Recreational Sports Guidelines distributed by the Illinois Department of Commerce
