

THUNDER BASEBALL COVID-19 Plan

Thunder & ESAA Baseball field use plan for Stage 4

1. Field set up
 - A. No use of bleacher for non-players, player dugouts will be half the team inside and half the team behind the dugout. No one allowed within 10 feet of these areas.
 - B. No non-player will be allowed to be within 10 feet of the area from the first base dugout, behind the backstop, to the third base dugout.
 - C. Parents will be allowed to be in groups of family only, but must maintain social distancing from others down the outfield out of play lines.
 - D. Dugout will be sprayed with a CDC approved sanitizer before and after practices and games.
 - E. Hand sanitizer will be available in every dugout.
 - F. No restrictions on field.
2. Players
 - A. Must have their own equipment.
 - B. No shaking hands or touching another person
 - C. Use hand sanitizer before practice, every dugout visit, and leaving practice.
 - D. Exercise or try to manage as much social distancing as possible.
 - E. No restrictions on field.
3. Coaches
 - A. No contact with players. Must keep social distance.
 - B. Coaches may sit inside field on buckets, that way they can communicate with bench.
 - C. Use of hand sanitizer the same as the player.
4. Equipment
 - A. Each team has their own game balls.
 - B. NO SHARING ANY EQUIPMENT
5. Umpires
 - A. They can stand wherever their administration desires.
 - B. Edgebrook recommends 11u and above behind the plate.
 - C. Head coach has final call.
6. Thillens stadium.
 - A. 20% capacity
 - B. No restrictions on field.
 - C. Bench and bleacher are the dugouts.
 - D. Coaches outside, in front of dugout allowed.
 - E. Fan must social distance in stands and have a mask on hand.
7. Rosemont Stadium
 - A. Temperature check upon entry.
 - B. 50 allowed on field
 - C. 20% field capacity with social distancing
